Two scholarships will be awarded for \$1,000 in the form of a check payable to the student and the college or university they are attending. This scholarship will be given based on the following criteria:

- Scholastic achievement
- Participation in and service to their school and community
- Must be of good standing and maintain an overall GPA of 3.00 or higher
- Essay submission

Important information about the MCEC/MACU Scholarship:

- Each applicant must currently be a senior enrolled in Michigan City High School or Marquette Catholic High School.
- All scholarships will be issued in the name of the applicant and their attending college unless otherwise decided by Members Advantage Credit Union and Michigan City Exchange Club.
- All applications submitted will become the property of Members Advantage Credit Union and Michigan City Exchange Club.
- Please provide your UNOPENED transcript from your current high school or college that must accompany this application. Do not make this a part of the application. The school you attend will provide your transcript in a SEALED envelope. DO NOT OPEN IT. Paperclip your transcript to the finished application, or transcripts can be directly sent to the credit union.
- All opened or "tampered" transcripts will be disqualified and will disqualify your complete scholarship application.
- You must answer all questions asked. Please type all answers on a clearly labeled 8.5" x 11" piece of paper.

- All answers listed on a corresponding paper must be typed, easy to read, and include the corresponding question. All applications received become the property of Members Advantage Credit Union/Michigan City Exchange Club and will not be returned.
- Do NOT include a photo of yourself. Members Advantage Credit Union/ Michigan City Exchange Club will award this scholarship based on school information, scholastic/community participation, AND essay.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered for this scholarship.
- All walk-in or mailed-in applications must be received by November 15,
- All participating applicants will be notified of the results.
- Winner of the Michigan City Exchange Club/Members Advantage Credit Union Scholarship is not eligible to win any other scholarship from Members Advantage Credit Union.
