Another way to protect you and your family is to shred important documents containing sensitive information, such as bank account numbers and social security numbers. Every year, we have a Shred Day open to the community.

This year's annual Shred Day is on June 24th at 9 am at our Michigan City branch. At Shred Day, you can easily and quickly shred essential documents.
